Hinton Recipe - Lavender Biscuits

- Butter (8oz/ 230g)
- Caster Sugar (4oz 115g)
- 1 egg
- Self Raising Flour (6oz/ 170g)
- 1 Tablespoon dried lavender flowers

Beat butter & sugar Add lightly beaten egg Fold in flour & lavender



Put generous teaspoons of mixture on baking tray lined with greaseproof paper Bake 10 minutes 190°C fan 180°C 10 minutes
