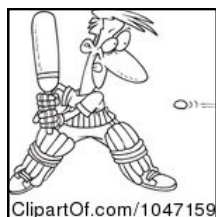


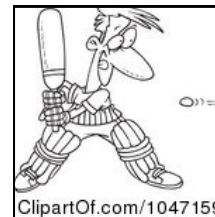

Curates Corner

In June the church's year reaches its climax with the celebrations of Pentecost (Whitsunday) and Trinity Sunday. At Pentecost Christians celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit and at Trinity we acknowledge the power of God, Father Son and Holy Spirit in our lives.

The Church then goes into "ordinary" mode after all the excitement of Christmas and Easter. Throughout all the seasons of the church's year there are different hymns, different colours in church, different words used in the services, all of which keeps the pattern of the year interesting, challenging yet also familiar and secure. 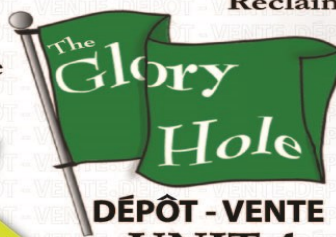
